BeWise Program

BeWise services for women 50-64 is an extension of the Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening. Eligibility is based on household income and women with insurance may qualify. Services include free blood pressure check, pap test, cholesterol and blood sugar screening, and a voucher for a free mammogram. A Lifestyle Coach will review screenings and assist women in setting personal goals. Welcome Baby is a home visitation program for infants and their parents in Utah County. It is sponsored by Utah County Health Department and United Way of Utah County. Nurses visit babies who are premature, on Medicaid or have other developmental risk factors. Paraprofessionals visit Spanish speaking families and United Way volunteers visit first time parents.

There is no cost for the visits. Information is available on early childhood development and community resources.
